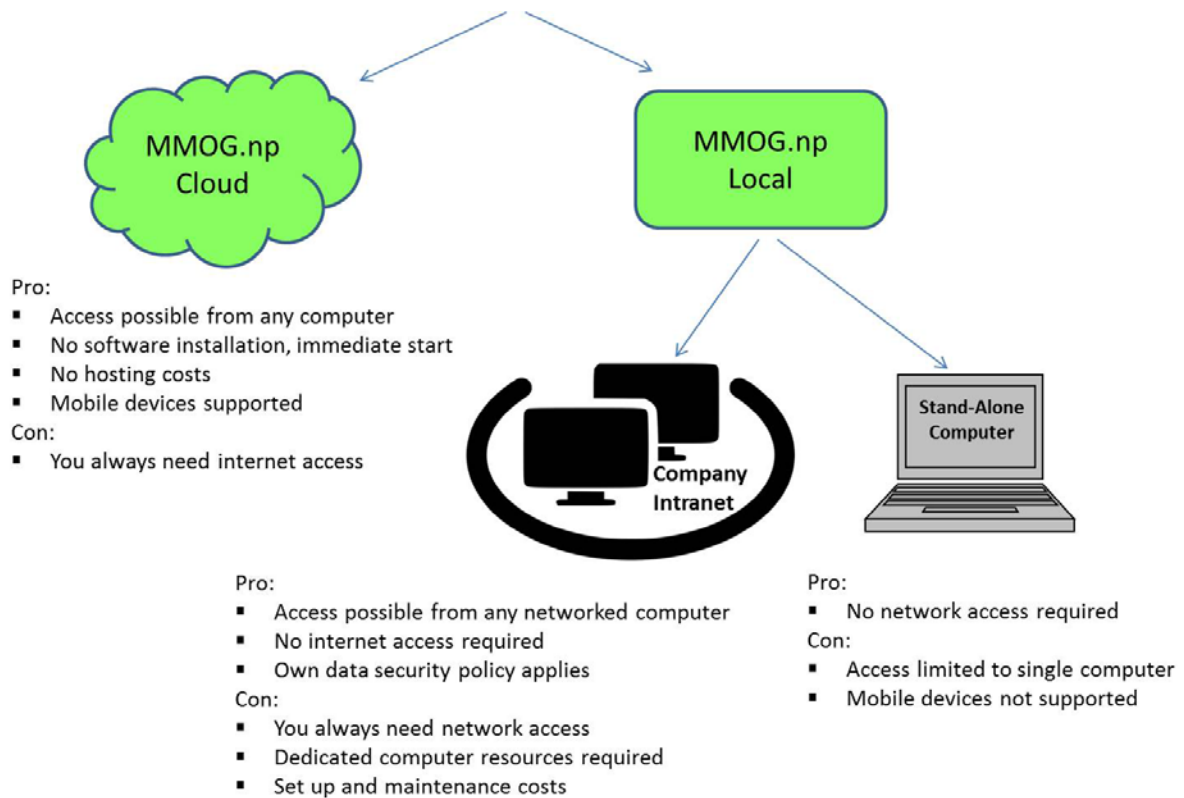


## Choose the solution that's right for your business



If you have to prepare assessments for several sites across your company, then accessing MMOG.np via the public internet (cloud) or via your private company intranet (local) using a multiple site licence provides a number of additional advantages compared with installing MMOG.np on a desktop computer (local):

- Assessments for all sites will be available in one central repository
- Management of sites, users and assessments will be centralised

The easiest way to get started is to use the internet application hosted by Odette on a secure server but, if your users cannot always access the internet or your company policy does not allow you to store this kind of data in the public cloud, then you will probably need to install MMOG.np locally.

In this case, if you have several users working with the system, it is strongly recommended to use a server installation in your company intranet. We recommend long time support (LTS) Ubuntu operating system (currently, version 18.04) but it is possible to use other Linux operating systems or Windows servers.

If you have just one user dealing with MMOG assessments, a local installation on a single desktop or laptop computer can be considered. Note: It is possible to manage several sites on a single desktop computer (with an appropriate licence).
